WHAT WILL YOU DO AS A QUALITY EMPLOYEE AT TABB?

It is important to perform quality checks at the end of a production process. These will determine whether the final product has any defects that would make it unsuitable for installation. However, it is also possible, and even desirable, to detect quality problems earlier in the process. By implementing quality control points throughout production, we can identify non-conforming products more quickly. This reduces unnecessary costs from producing defective products to completion.

The essential components of TABB's quality control for Tabb:

- Inspection this involves examining incoming goods, finished products and processes to identify any deviations from established quality standards
- Testing this involves performing tests and measurements to assess various elements of products to determine quality Are you involved in configuration management
- Statistical process control statistical techniques can be used to monitor production processes and ensure they remain within expected quality standards
- Corrective action once defects have been identified, this involves implementing actions to manage or eliminate them, preventing their recurrence
- Documentation and records it is important to keep records of your inspections, tests and corrective actions as this can assist in future investigations and demonstrates due diligence
- Training employees must be trained to meet the necessary quality standards
- Continuous improvement an effective quality control process should result in continuous improvement within a company
